

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY AND HONOR CODE

1. The Competition is open to all who willing to take part in it. No restrictions to citizenship or place of living.
2. One person can take part in different nominations (categories) of the Competition. A participant's account is linked to email. To take part in two or more nominations (categories) a participant has to register himself using different email addresses. In case if participant gets to the Finals in more than one nomination (category), he has to choose just one in which he will take part.
3. Participant take responsibility for giving true information. Their solutions must be their own work and must not be shared with others unless it explicitly permitted by organisers or jury members.

2. SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES AND SOLUTIONS

1. Entries are submitted online in period from the **8th of January 2018** till the **4th February 2018 (included)**.
2. All registered participants receive a link to the task in their profiles according to the selected nomination(s) and category(-ies). The tasks are prepared by Jury Members. The solutions have to be done and submitted within a period from **the 5th of February 2018** till the **19th of February 2018 (included)**.
3. Each participant can submit several solutions. System will take into account the last submitted variant.
4. The organiser reserves the right to reject tasks or participation in case of the violation of the Rules. The submission deadline is the **19th of February 2018**, before **11.59pm (UTC)**
5. Participants are entirely responsible for providing conditions for Internet access and other technical capabilities for registration in the Competition and submitting their solutions in time.

6. Participants, whose solutions will be selected by Jury members as the best, can take part in the Final stage of the Competition. The Final is offline and is held in Krakow, Poland on **the 24-25th of March 2018**. Finalists will compete side by side at one place during the challenging time.
7. Participants are entirely responsible for providing themselves with notebooks, tickets to get to the location of the Final, the place to stay at during the Final (hotel, hostel etc.), visa to Poland (if needed). Organisers may provide participants with needed information.

3. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

1. By submitting a solution for the Competition, the participant will be regarded as having granted the Organiser the right to publish it on the website.
2. Solutions received by the Organiser through the competition will not be used by the Organiser for commercial purposes.
3. All photos of the participants made by the Organiser during the event can be used for future promotion of the Competition at media, internet etc.

4. PRIZES

1. Prizes are non-transferable and non-exchangeable for cash or in kind.
2. The Organiser reserves the right to change or replace the competition prizes and/or modify the rules and regulations of the Competition as and when necessary, with prior notice.
3. The Organiser shall not be liable for any fault with any of the prizes and any issues or queries relating to the condition of the prizes should be referred to the manufacturer/supplier of the prizes.

5. JUDGING AND RESULTS

1. The solutions will be selected by a panel of judges and their decision is final. No correspondence pertaining to the selection process and decision will be entertained except for feedback from the judge with comments to the solution.

2. The panel of judges will evaluate the solutions based on the criteria depending on the nominations.
3. Results of the Competition will be posted on the IT Challenges 3 website and winners will also be notified via email.
4. Results of the Finals will be announced on the second day of it at the location of the Finals. Participants can win the 1st, the 2nd or the 3d place in their category and nomination.

6. ACCEPTANCE OF RULES AND REGULATIONS

By submitting a solution for the competition, the participant will be regarded as having accepted and agreed to be bound by the rules and regulations of the Competition.
